

## **Activist Denies Any Role**

**NEW HAVEN, May 20 (UPI)** — Stewart Albert, an antiwar activist, said today that he spent the night of the Capitol bombing in Washington with Miss Bacon and that neither of them had been involved in its planning or execution.

Mr. Albert, 31 years old, said that he, Miss Bacon and a girl he identified as Judy Gumbo of Boston were in a Washington apartment at the time of the bombing. "An F.B.I. agent has told me I was a suspect in the Capitol bombing," he said. "I had nothing to do with it. Neither did Miss Bacon nor Miss Gumbo."
